## English for Speakers of Other Languages



ESOL classes offer help with practical English needed for daily life, employment and further study

The friendly classes give students the skills and confidence to use more accurate grammar and a wider vocabulary. Students work towards their personal learning aims.

All four skills – Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening are taught throughout the course. You will be able to take Skills for Life, ESOL exams during the year and the cost of these are included in the course fees. Students will take exams at the end of each semester.



## English as a Foreign Language



Cambridge English: First (FCE) is an international certificate which is recognised around the world and is ideal for anyone who wants to work or study abroad. It is particularly suitable for au pairs who have come to the UK to study English.

Cambridge English: First is an upper intermediate level exam and set at Level B2 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework for modern languages. It is suitable for learners who have a wide range of vocabulary and are able to study or work in an English-speaking environment.

This exam is taken by more than 270,000 people each year in more than 100 countries. It is a valuable qualification for anyone who wants to develop a career which requires language skills, including business, medicine, engineering and many other professions. It is also useful preparation for higher level examinations, such as the Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English and the Certificate of Proficiency in English. Exams can be taken throughout the year at nearby colleges.
