


Light and Experience: The hidden materials of the architectural process.

You can still sign up for a special practical virtual Architecture taster session on 4 May from 11.00am-12.30pm.

The aim of this session is to give students an insight into studying Architecture at the University of Suffolk to encourage them to get handson with simple materials to explore light and its relationship to architectural structure.

To make this possible we recommend that students have use of the following materials

- 5 x A4 paper sheets
- 1 x recycled cardboard (e.g. cereal boxes or vegetable tray)
- 1 x recycled plastic tray (e.g. jaffa cakes or biscuit tray)
- 1x piece of sand paper, pencil, mobile phone, torch, scissors, mat
