If you are also applying for DSA there is a section in the application to do this.

If you do not know where you are going to university yet, put down where you think you will go.

You can contact Student Finance later on, if this changes.

Applications should be done by May at the latest to guarantee you receive Student Finance payments when you start your course in the Autumn.

You may have heard in the news about changes to Student Finance repayments.

If you are going to university in 2022, these will not affect you.

Any changes will apply to 2023 entrants eg those taking a Gap Year or deferring entry.
