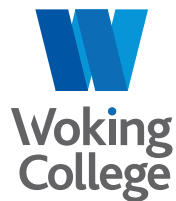

ESOL

English for Speakers of Other Languages

These friendly classes give students the skills and confidence to use more accurate grammar and a wider vocabulary. Students work towards their personal learning aims.

All four skills – Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening are taught throughout the course. You will be able to take Skills for Life, ESOL exams during the year and the cost of these are included in the course fees. Students will take exams at the end of each semester.

GCSE MATHS & ENGLISH

Adult Classes

These courses are for adults wanting to take GCSE English or Maths for the first time or for those wanting to re-take it. These nationally recognised qualifications are required for many careers and higher education courses.

The Course

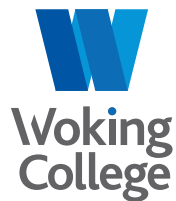
This course will help you to improve your ability to represent and analyse data, use algebra and solve problems. Many students take this course in order to progress in Higher Education courses.
