

Qualification purpose

This qualification is designed to provide learners with an in-depth understanding of the principles of the uniformed services sector and to allow them to explore the various avenues of work within it. It will also allow learners to gain transferable skills that can be applied to the workplace or further study.

Task 1- Research Task

Research a public service which you are interested to join. Services are:

- Police
- Fire
- Ambulance
- Army
- Navy
- RAF.



Find the key information which is needed to join that services. This can be done as a poster or a mind map.







Task 2- Favourite Service

What characteristics do you need to join that services? (For the one you did the poster on above)

Pick the three main characteristics and describe why you think you need them for your chosen service and say why.

Extension 1: For each characteristic you need to give the strengths and weakness of that characteristics.

Eg: Bravery – *this is a good trait as it means that the service person won't be anxious when doing the job. A weakness of this characteristic is that the service person might do something that could put them in trouble.*

Extension 2: Justify why if they didn't have these traits what might happen to the chosen service / service person.

Eg: why not might not get promoted or they might miss something while doing their Job which could cause an accident.

Please try not to use my example.



Task 3- About You

What are your top 5 characteristics and why? (these can be done in a list). Please explain why you have these characteristics.

Extension

Write two short paragraphs summarising why you would be good in your chosen public service. Try and make sure that you use examples and justify your answer. You. Yes you. What about you?

Key words

Describe Give a clear description that includes all the relevant features - think of it as 'painting a picture with words'

Explain Set out in detail the meaning of something, with reasons. More difficult than describe or list, so it can help to give an example to show what you mean. Start by introducing the topic then give the 'how' or 'why'

Justify How/ Why Give reasons or evidence to support your opinion or view to show how you arrived at these conclusions
