### **English for Speakers of Other Languages**

These friendly classes give students the skills and confidence to use more accurate grammar and a wider vocabulary. Students work towards their personal learning aims.

All four skills – Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening are taught throughout the course. You will be able to take Skills for Life, ESOL exams during the year and the cost of these are included in the course fees. Students will take exams at the end of each semester.

The cost of the course depends on your circumstances – for example whether you are from the EU or not, or whether you are on certain types of benefits. Please see the table below for details.



This course will help you to improve your ability to represent and analyse data, use algebra and solve problems. Many students take this course in order to progress in Higher Education courses.


