- You must also come for an Information, Advice and Guidance session, (see dates on the right) where you will meet the teacher and take an assessment test to make sure that this is the right course for you.

This test will take about an hour.

Please bring your passport to the Information, Advice and Guidance Evening.

You will be informed within a few days of your assessment test whether you have been accepted on the course. There are limited numbers so students will be accepted on a first come, first served basis from the date of application as long as they fulfil the course criteria.
