The <u>King & Wood Mallesons Global Introduction to Law Programme</u> (which is specifically designed for high school students/sixth form). For something more stretching, try <u>White & Case</u>.

The <u>Accenture Discovery Programme</u> is focused on developing a range of soft skills (like communication, stakeholder management and prioritisation) as well as technical skills relating to consulting and innovation.

The <u>RMP/DBL Work Readiness Programme</u> empowers students to develop skills that are important across all industries and are particularly helpful in the current environment we find ourselves in (e.g. wellbeing, resilience, mindfulness).

These virtual work experience opportunities are all free of charge.
