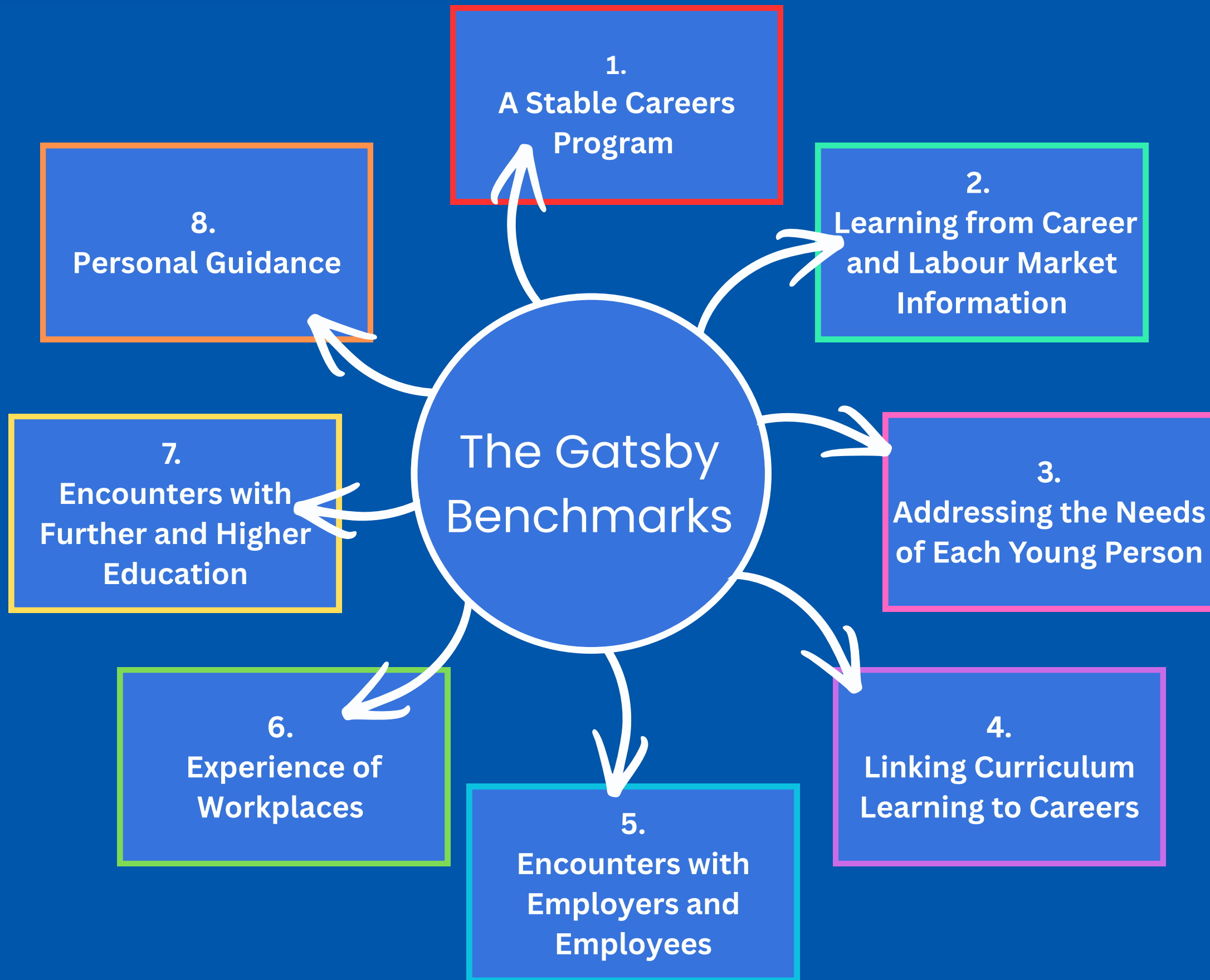




1. Woking College has an embedded programme of careers education and guidance which is shared with all stakeholders.

2. Woking College shares up-to-date information about future pathways, study options and labour market opportunities and students with SEND receive bespoke support.

3. Careers guidance is tailored to the needs and stage of each student and they are supported to navigate any barriers to career progression.

4. Teachers link curriculum learning with careers and progression routes and highlight the relevance of knowledge and skills developed in their subject.

5. Each student has multiple opportunities to learn from employers about the workplace, through careers fairs, visits and guest speakers.

6. Every student is able to have first-hand experiences of workplaces during a dedicated work experience week.

7. All students are made aware of the range of learning opportunities available to them after college, including academic, technical and vocational routes.

8. Every student has opportunities for guidance meetings with a qualified careers adviser and can book guidance meetings across the year.
